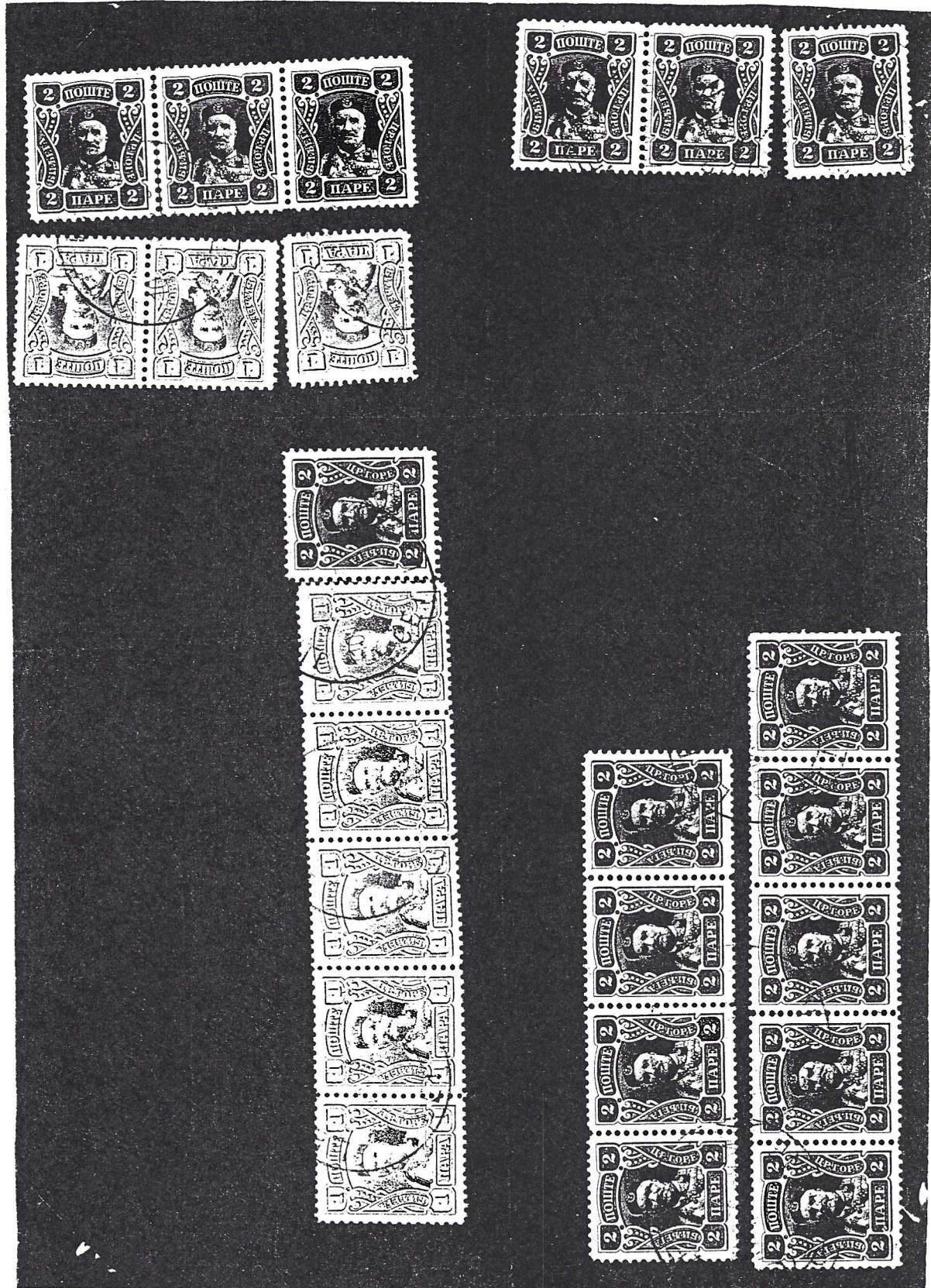


THIRD DEFINITIVES OF PRINCE NICHOLAS

Spectacular franking with eight 1 para and sixteen 2 para stamps paying a total of 40 para on a registered cover front sent to the British Embassy in Rome. Apparently the envelope was used to send photographs. A most unusual usage.

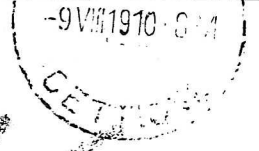
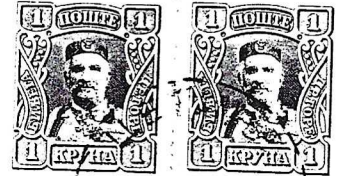

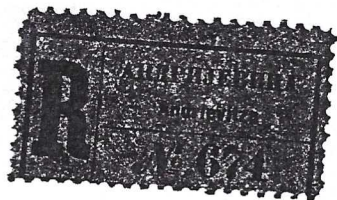

Multiple franking of nine copies of the 25 para stamp, including two vertical strips of three, used on parcel address card from the Bank of Montenegro to the National Bank of Serbia. Value declared of 150 krana. The parcel transited the Hungarian post office at Zemun, and a Serbian fiscal was applied on receipt in Belgrade.

Cover from Andrijevica to Cetinje franked with 10 and 25 para stamps to pay the rate for a domestic registered letter. Added 25 para "A.R." stamp (cancelled in manuscript) pays the return receipt fee.



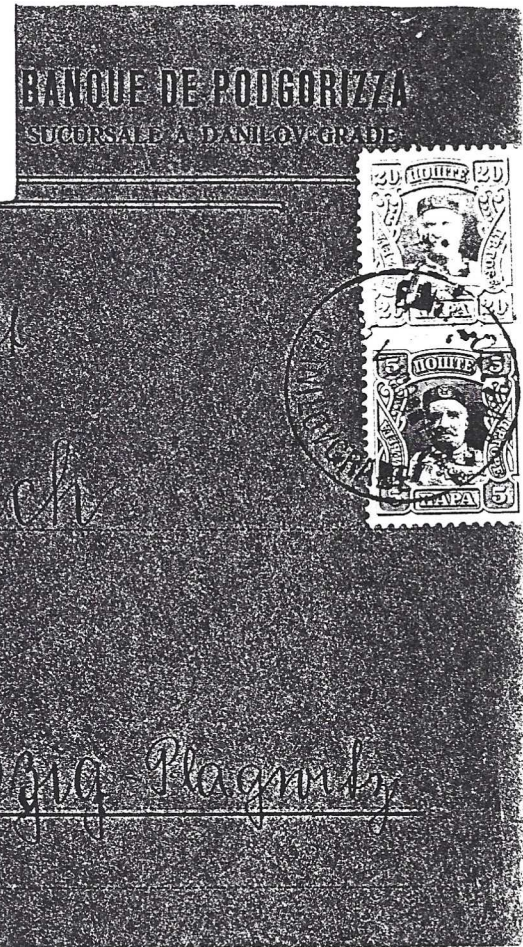
## THIRD DEFINITIVES OF PRINCE NICHOLAS

On 1 June 1907, a new, attractively engraved set of 12 definitive stamps depicting Prince Nicholas was issued. As the first Montenegrin coins, denominated in para instead of helera, had been struck in 1906, the low values of this set were the first stamps to bear this new nomenclature.

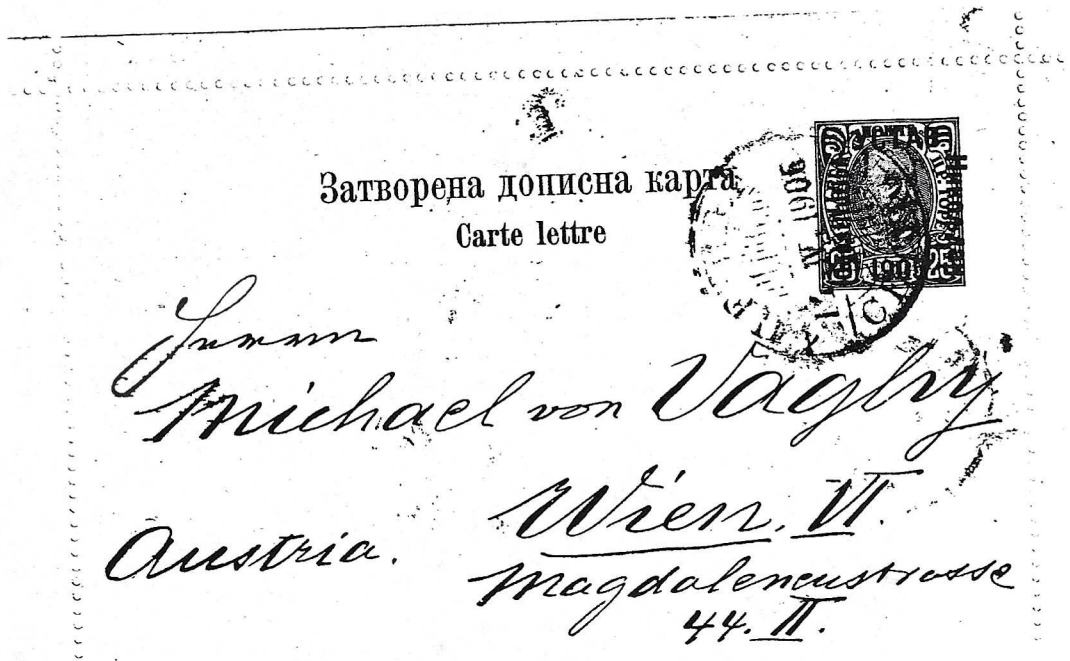


Upper example of a pair of the 2 para plus a 1 para adhesive used to upgrade a domestic postal card for international use to the Netherlands. Cover franked with 5 and 20 para stamps pays the international letter rate.

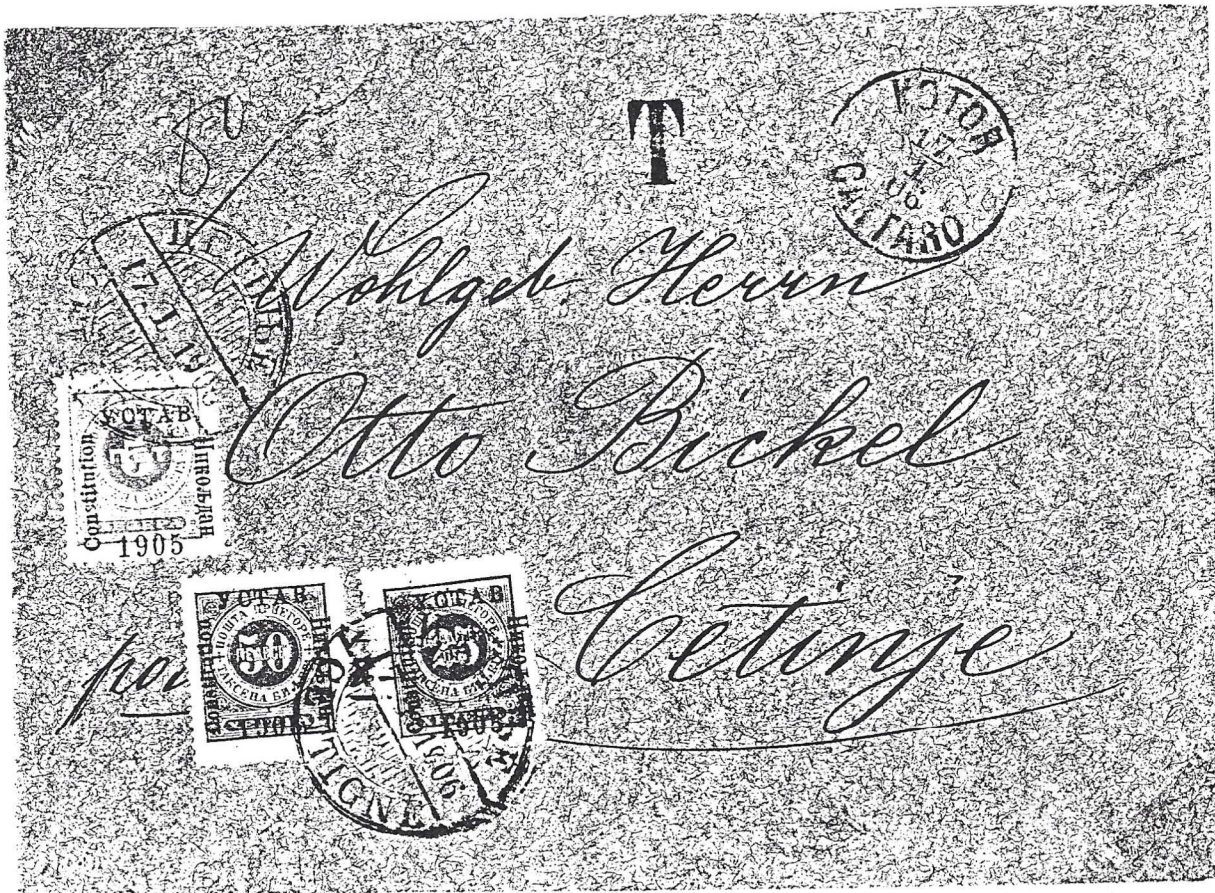
Postal stationery in the second Prince Nicholas design was duly overprinted to commemorate the new Constitution. Contrary to the earlier practice, however, this was only done to the international rated pieces.
