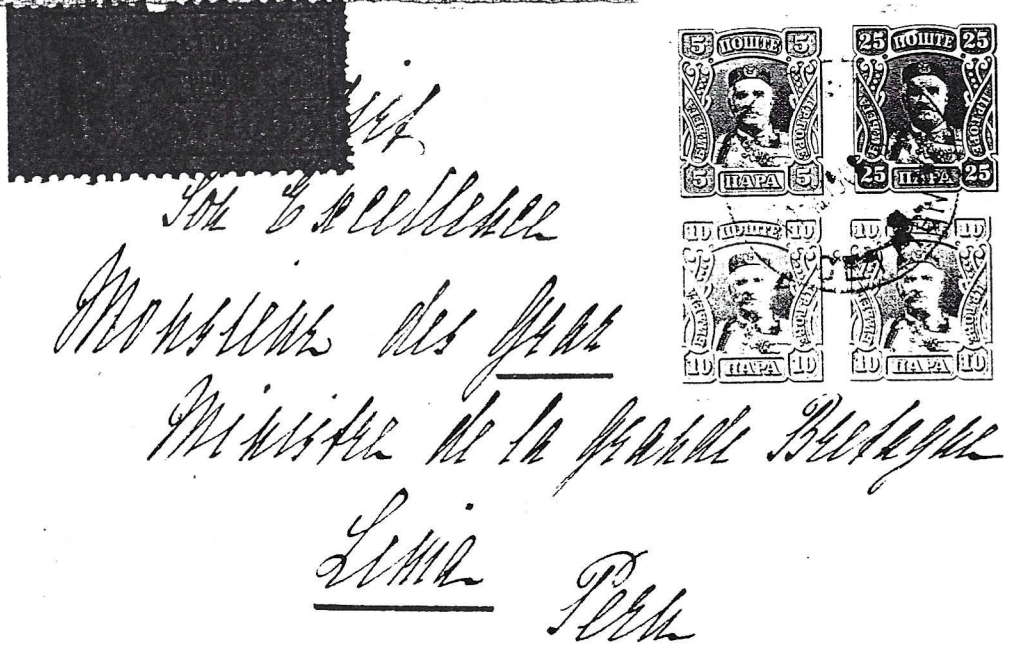
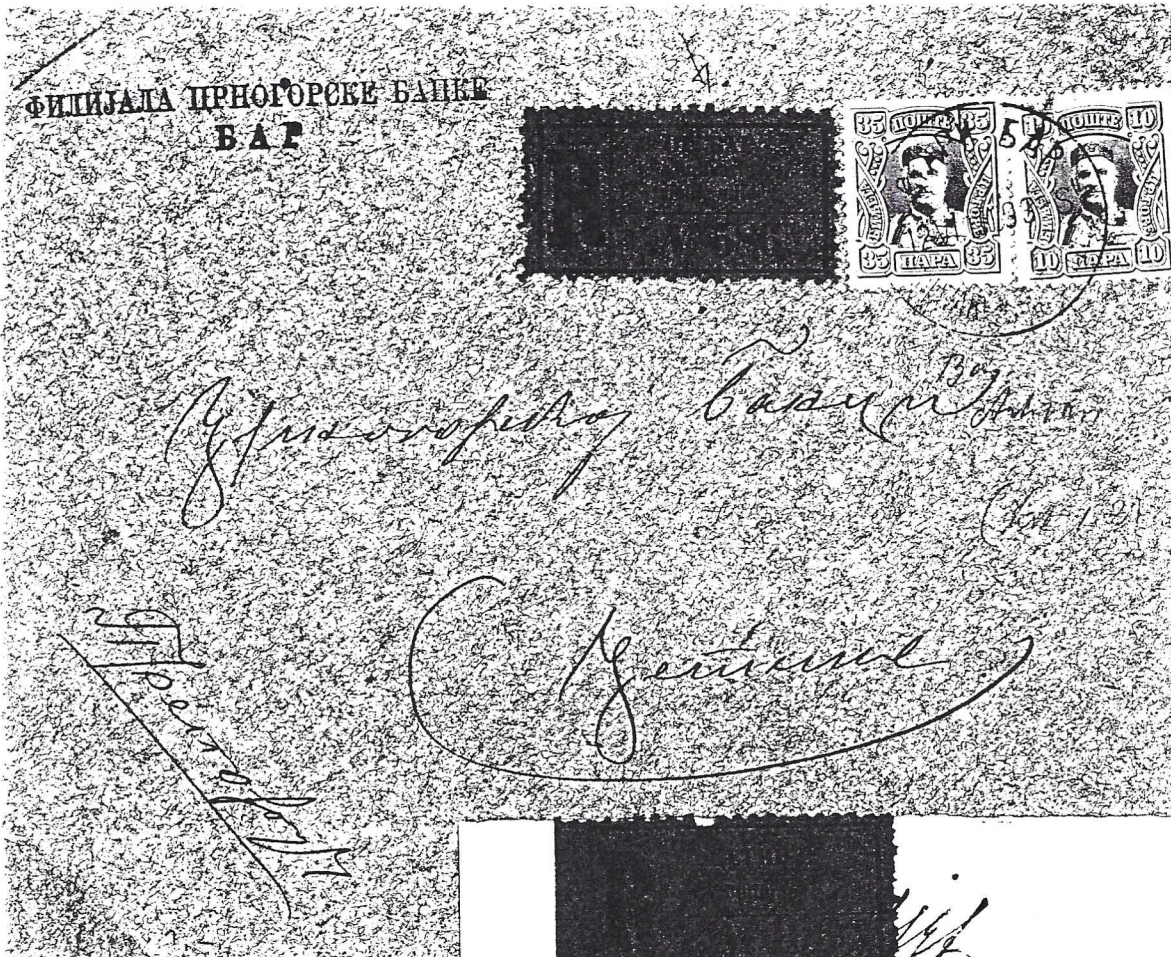


THIRD DEFINITIVES OF PRINCE NICHOLAS

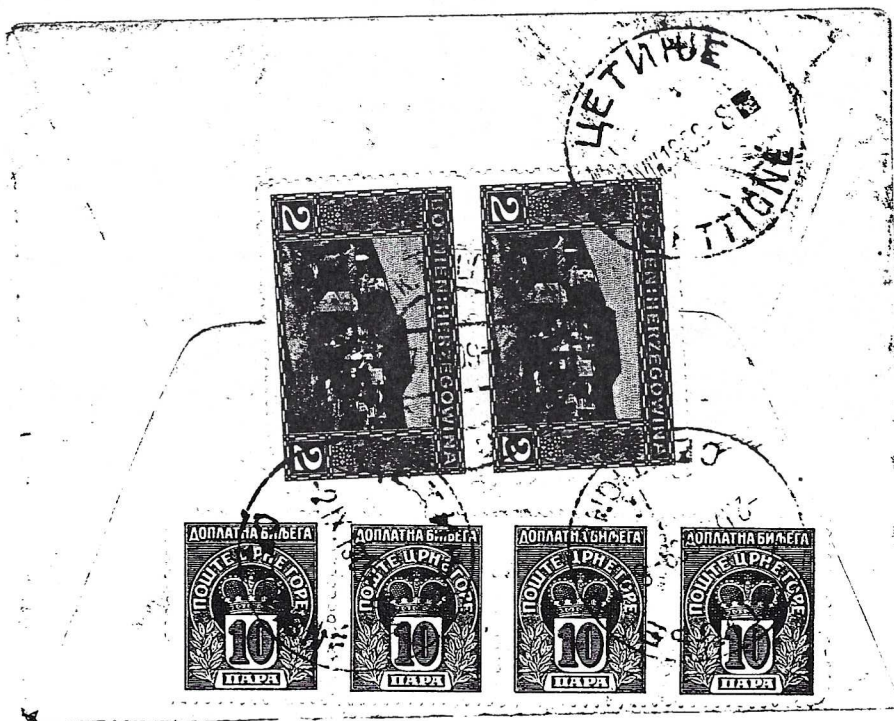

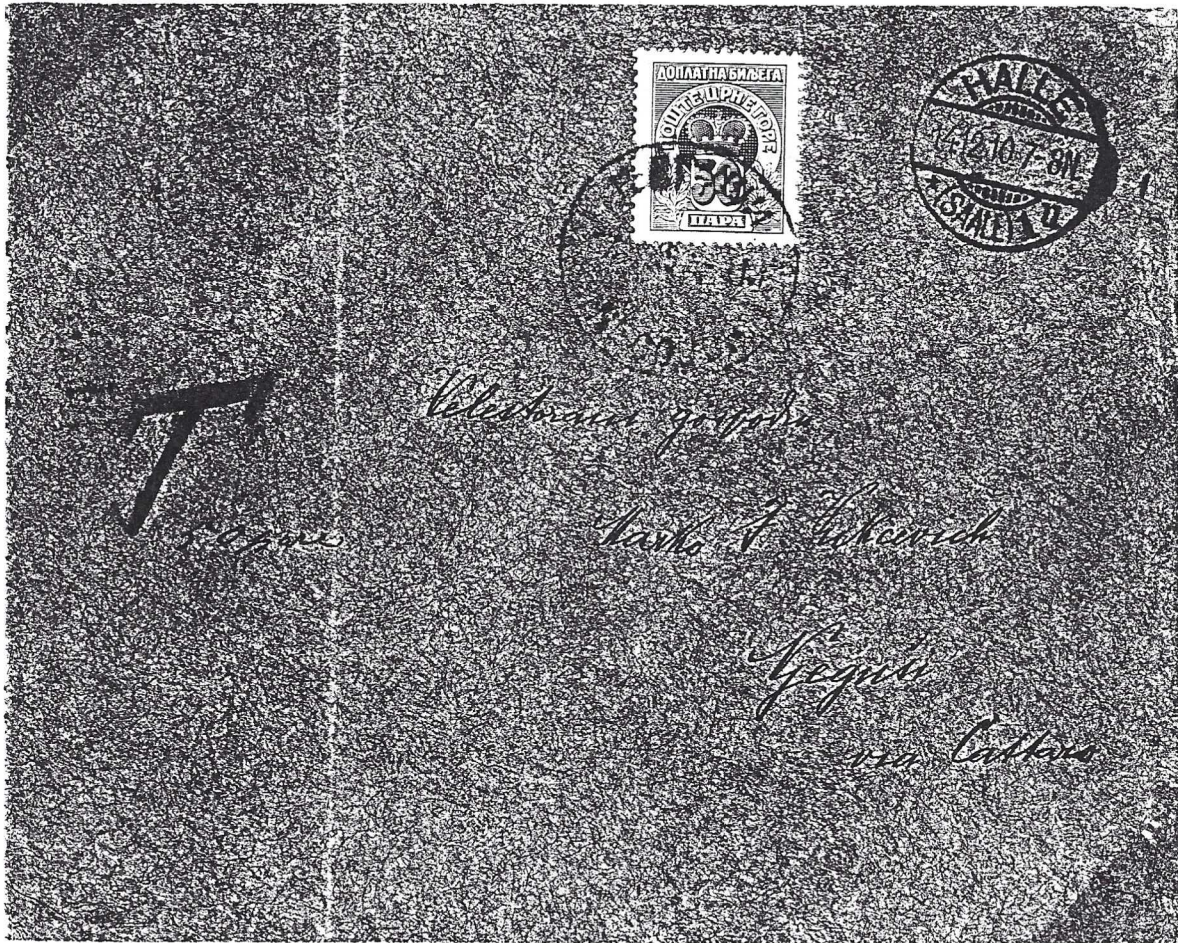

Related to but not a part of the third Prince Nicholas definitives, postage dues were also required in the new para denominations. They were issued on 1 June 1907. The 5 and 10 para values shown here on underpaid postcard from Austria and letter from Bosnia-Hercegovina.

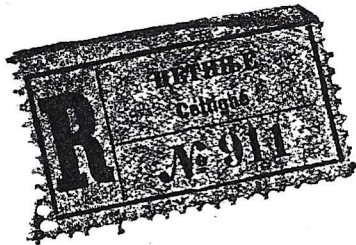


Example shown is a 50 para due of the 1907 set used on an unfranked letter from Germany to Njegusi. It paid the normal postage rate of 25 para plus a deficiency charge of an equal amount.

PROCLAMATION OF THE KINGDOM

The year 1910 provided an occasion for significant celebration in Montenegro. In addition to being 50 years since the accession of Prince Nicholas, it was also the golden wedding anniversary of the Prince and his wife. Nicholas took advantage of the occasion to upgrade his status, declaring that the country was now a kingdom. In addition, it was considered appropriate that there be a new Montenegrin currency, the perper, equivalent to the old krana. (However, the new banknotes were not ready until 1912 so the old Austrian ones continued to circulate.) Thus, on 28 August 1910, a twelve-value Jubilee set was issued to commemorate the events.

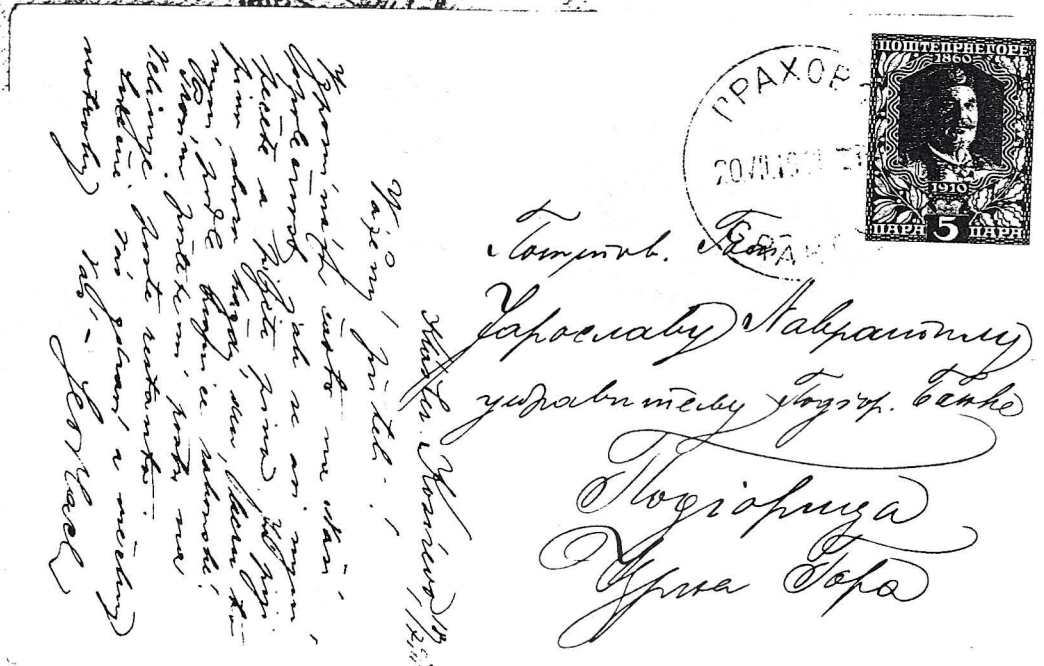

As befitting the occasion, the design and engraving of the Jubilee series was entrusted to the Viennese team of Moser and Schimbock, who had prepared the outstanding Austrian and Bosnian Jubilee sets. Certainly the new stamps, depicting King Nicholas and Queen Milena at various ages, were widely acclaimed as works of art.

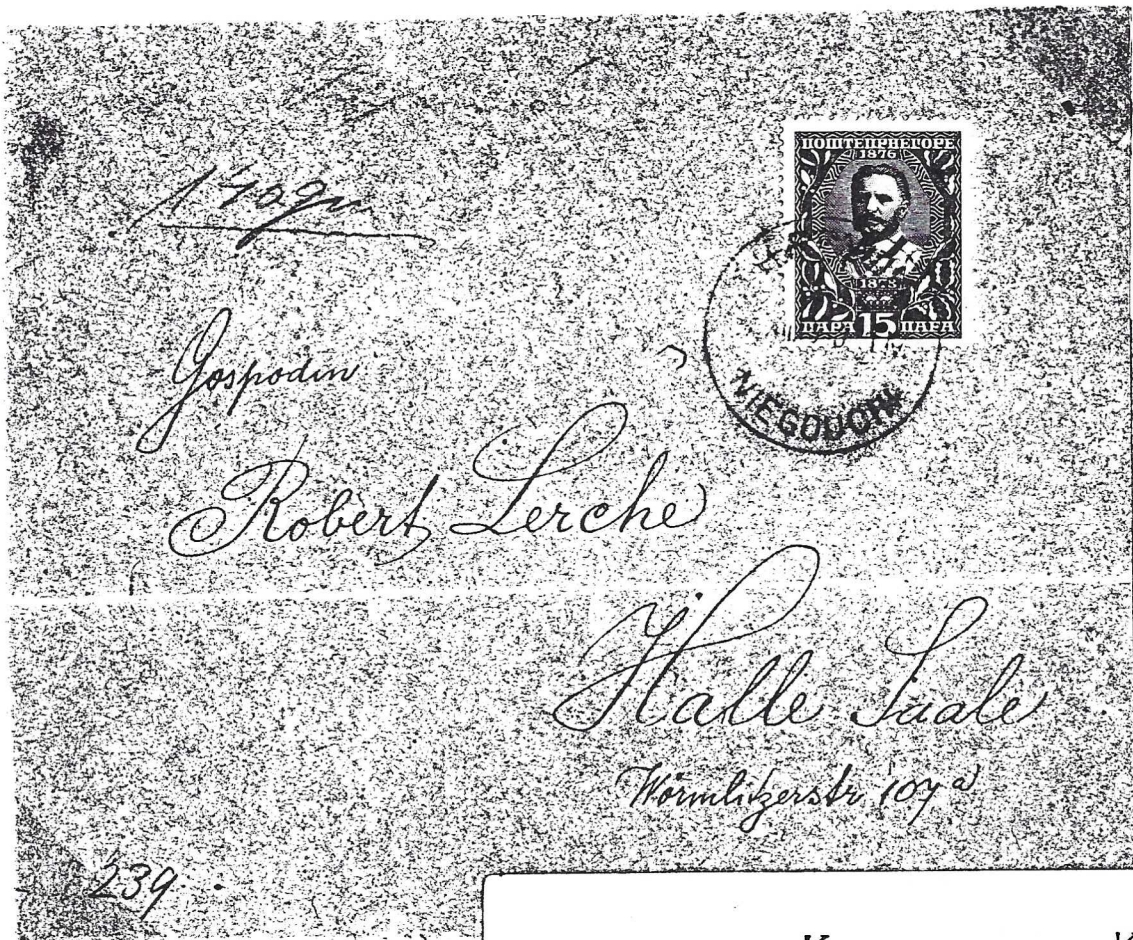


Lower values of the Jubilee set are shown used on registered cover to Switzerland and on a domestic postcard.
