### WHO WE ARE

We began as The War Cover Club in 1937. Our principal focus then centered on researching the postal history of the American Expeditionary Forces (AEF) in World War I. While the term "war covers" appears, at first glance, to raise connotations of a limited or specialized field of collecting, reflection on the subject will reveal the tremendous scope encompassed under this heading. The collecting and exhibiting interests of the membership are thus not limited to soldier campaign covers, but include patriotic, prisoner of war, naval, occupation and internment covers. Also, picture postcards of a military nature, camp cancels, propaganda labels and leaflets, V-mail, censored mail and other related material and covers.

To reflect this broadening of scope, in August 1991 the membership voted to change the name of the Club to the Military Postal History Society. The Society has grown considerably, both in size and interest, and now includes collectors throughout the world. Members specialize in almost all aspects of military history, both U.S. and foreign.

The Society, through publication of our quarterly MPHS Bulletin and the efforts of our editor, gathers and publishes original articles from members on all phases of military philately. These articles represent detailed research and examination of a variety of material and often contain information not found elsewhere.

The mail bid auction conducted by the Society and offered

in almost every issue of the Bulletin provides a prime source of material for members. These sales give members an opportunity to dispose of duplicate or surplus material and to acquire new items.

The Society also publishes several military source books, among which are listings of military post offices and other war related postal history studies. Research on and publication of new resources for collectors remain ongoing.
