The War Cover Club was established in 1937. Its principal interest was focused around researching the postal history of the AEF in World War I. While the term “war covers” appears, at first glance, to raise connotations of a very limited or specialized field of collecting, reflection on the subject will reveal the tremendous scope encompassed under this heading. The collecting interests of the membership are not limited to soldier campaign covers, but include patriotic, prisoner of war, naval, occupation and internment covers, picture postcards of a military nature, camp cancels, propaganda labels and leaflets, V-mail, censored mail and other related material and covers.

The Club has grown considerably, both in size and interest, and now included members throughout the world. They specialize in almost every area of military history, both U.S. and foreign. In August 1991 the membership voted to change the name of the Club to the Military Postal History Society.

The Society, through its quarterly bulletin and the untiring efforts of its editor, gathers and publishes original articles from members on all phases of military philately. These articles often represent detailed research and examination of a variety of material and contains information usually not found elsewhere.

The mail bid auction conducted by the Society and contained in almost every issue of the Bulletin are a prime source of material for members. These sales give members the opportunity to dispose of duplicate, or surplus, material and to acquire new items.

The Society also publishes several military source books among which are listings of Military Post Offices and other war related postal history studies.
