Recorded December 1925 (ERD shown here) - May 1927. It is likely that strikes of the postmark shown below are included in this date range. Differences in size of the dial and in the type appear greater than can be accounted for by tropical effects. It is likely that 2 different postmarks are involved.

Use of Haitian postage is exceptional (and illegal).
No postage due charges were indicated on the cover.

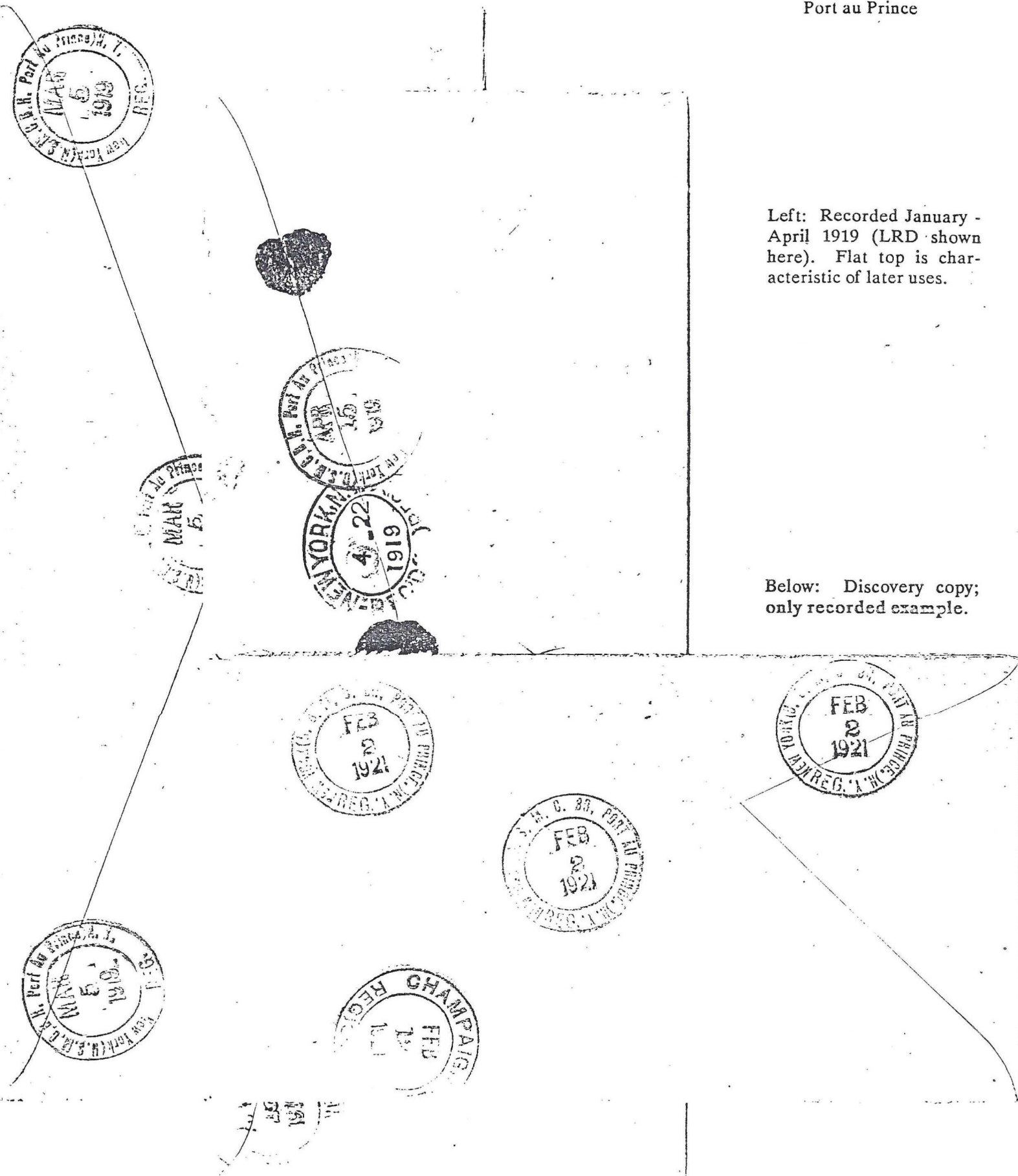
According to USMC records the Constabulary Detachment post office operated in Port au Prince from 1 March 1927 through the end of 1933. Only 1 regular and 1 registry mail postmark are recorded. Postmark above previously recorded January 1928 - July 1933. The distorted killer bars are characteristic of strikes from January 1928 and later, suggesting that the upper 2 examples are from April 1927 (thus making 20 April 1927 the new ERD).

Left: Recorded January - April 1919 (LRD shown here). Flat top is characteristic of later uses.

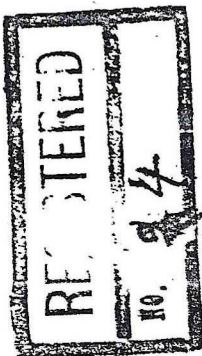

The U.S. Marine Corps post office in Cape Haitien opened in April 1918 and closed in August 1934. It used at least 6 regular mail postmarks, 2 Registry and 1 Money Order Business daters.

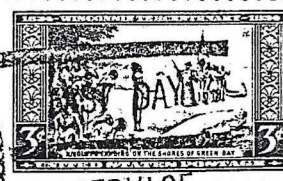
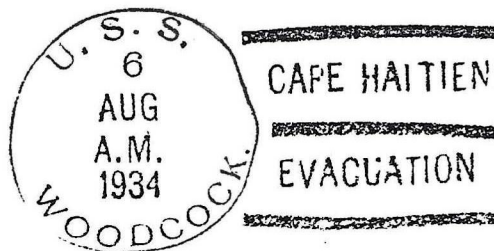
