On 15 October 1918 the Polish members of the Austrian Reichsrat declared that they were "citizens of a free and re-united Polish State." However, the Etappenpost system operated until Austria surrendered to the Allies on 3 November. Thereafter, the Polish authorities continued to operate the post offices although removing the wording "K.u.K. Etappenpostamt" from the cancellations.
